<b>Outline of travel and accommodation logistics</b>	Ian, Angus, and Lindsey McKerrell were members of the GB team, and all travel and logistics were arranged by the team officials
<b>Outline of Competition Logistics</b>	<p>Competitions in Camp Borden comprised a warm up day, with individual shoots at 300/600/900 and 1000 yards, followed by a team match the following day.</p> <p>Shooting at Camp Perry comprised 5 days of individual shoots and on the last 2 days, team shoots, the Commodore Perry (300/600/1000 yards) and the Mini-Palma (800/900/1000). All the shoots were 15 rounds to count at each range.</p> <p>At Connaught, there were individual matches early in the week, with a mixture of team and individual matches at the end of the week. The course of fire was specific to each competition, with variation in the number of scoring shots from 7 to 10 to 15 at each range.</p> <p>During the period at Camp Perry, the GB team experienced inexplicable problems with their ammunition, which were not similarly experienced in Canada. This led to larger group sizes across the team with subsequent reduction in scores.</p>
