Subsequently this was looked into by the ISSF and it was interesting to note that apparently there were no HITEX stiffness related disqualifications. All stiffness related DSQs were of canvas or canvas composite manufacture. Also there has been a question raised over the effectivity of the measuring equipment to be consistent in varying atmospheric conditions. No doubt more will be said on this in the future.
